- Tenderers who are willing to participate shall provide (i) **Company Name**, (ii) **Person in Charge**, (iii) **Contact Number** and (iv) **E-mail address** for the on-line Tender Briefing invitation purpose to tender.secretariat@mysarawakmetro.com on or **before 12:00 noon on 2 August 2023 (Wednesday)**.
 - Tenderers may participate either as (i) Single Entity or (ii) Joint Venture (JV) [in case of JV, JV shall not have more than three (3) partners]. Tenderers shall possess relevant experience and proven track record of having successfully completed Works of similar nature and meet the Mandatory Requirements by submitting the proof of registration, experience and compliance to the minimum qualification requirements as stated below:
 - Local Malaysian Contractors / Companies registered with:
 - Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) and/or Registrar of Business (ROB); and
 - Pejabat Setiausaha Kewangan Negeri Sarawak (UPKJ) issued by Sarawak State Financial Secretary Office, (Registration Category: Work, Classification: Class A); and
 - Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) Malaysia (Registration Category: Grade G7)
 - Contractors / Company incorporated in Malaysia with Foreign Shareholding – to provide Certified True Copy of the relevant Company Secretarial Documents;
 - Foreign Contractors / Companies Registered under SSM – to provide Certified True Copy of the relevant Company Secretarial Documents;
 - Minimum paid-up capital (based on latest financial year audited report:
 - for Single Entity in Ringgit Malaysia: Two Million (RM2,000,000.00) only
 - for Joint Venture in Ringgit Malaysia: Four Million (RM 4,000,000.00) only, combined for all partners and for Lead Partner Min. Ringgit Malaysia: One Million (RM1,000,000.00) only;
 - Average net profit for the last three (3) financial years (2019, 2020 and 2021 **OR** 2020, 2021 and 2022) shall be positive and for Joint Venture, minimum two (2) partners **MUST** be positive including the Lead Partner.
 - In addition, the Tenderer shall be required to meet the Minimum Qualification Requirements (MQR) as stated below:
 - Must be established more than ten (10) years as Infrastructure Contractor/ Company; and
 - Must have completed in last ten (10) years (i.e., between year 2013 to 2022) minimum one (1) similar project with a value of not less than RM 200 Million for each category as stated under NOTE below, and
 - Minimum average Annual Turnover (from construction receipts only) for the last three (3) financial years (2019, 2020 and 2021 **OR** 2020, 2021 and 2022) is (a) for single entity RM300 Million (b) for Joint Venture RM500 Million; and
 - The Proposed Project Director / Project Manager must have at least fifteen (15) years of experience in managing infrastructure projects that includes construction of Highway / Road, Bridge, Railways and other Urban Civil Infrastructure Projects, Airport / Hospital projects etc.

- Similar Project refers to:
 - Highways / road and/or bridges / viaducts and/or railway infrastructure consists of earthwork / bridges etc.;
 - Airport, Hospitals, Railway Station etc.
 - In the event the Tenderer is a JV, then the above requirements may be fulfilled by the partners jointly and they shall be required to submit related supporting documents for each of the items above as evidence/proof and associated civil works.
- Tender Document shall only be sold to "bona fide" representative of the Tenderers who attended the Tender Briefing session. Sarawak Metro **SHALL NOT** entertain any requisition for the purchase of Tender Document before and/or after the time stipulated.
 - Tenderers shall observe and comply with statutory requirements, rules and regulations, including and modifications to it or re-enactment that is enforced by the Government of Malaysia applicable to Sarawak.
