



1. Sarawak Metro Sdn Bhd (Sarawak Metro), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sarawak Economic Development Corporation (SEDC), has been entrusted by the Sarawak Government to develop a new transportation system, that is, **Kuching Urban Transportation System (KUTS)**. The KUTS project aims to transform Kuching into a dynamic and competitive city with the provision of green and efficient public transportation services for the Greater Kuching area with the introduction of the Autonomous Rapid Transit (ART). The ART will be the backbone of the public road transport in Kuching city and it will be supported by the feeder bus network in providing the first mile and last mile connectivity. KUTS will alleviate traffic congestion and improve urban connectivity, therefore creating more economic opportunities and enabling trade as well as facilitating access to broader markets and services.

4. Tenderers may participate either as (i) Single Entity or (ii) Joint Venture (JV) [in case of JV, JV shall not have more than three (3) partners. Tenderers shall possess relevant experience and proven track record of having successfully completed Works of similar nature and meet the Mandatory Requirements by submitting the proof of registration, experience and compliance to the minimum qualification requirements as stated below:
  - (a) Sarawak Companies / Manufacturer registered with:
    - i. Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) and/or Registrar of Business (ROB); and/or
    - ii. Registered under UPKJ (Category: Supply, Class A, Head I)
  - (b) Average Annual Turnover (only from contract receipts) for the last three (3) financial years (2020, 2021 and 2022) shall not less than RM40 Million
  - (c) Minimum paid-up capital (based on latest financial year audited report):
    - i. for Single Entity in Ringgit Malaysia: One Million (RM1,000,000.00) only
    - ii. for Joint Venture in Ringgit Malaysia: Two Million (RM 2,000,000.00) only, combined for all partners and for Lead Partner Min. Ringgit Malaysia: One Million (RM1,000,000.00) only;
  - (d) Average net profit for the last three (3) financial years (2020, 2021 and 2022) shall be positive and for Joint Venture, minimum two (2) partners MUST be positive including the Lead Partner.
  - (e) The Tenderer shall be required to meet the experience as stated below:
    - (i) Must have experience in manufacture and supply of precast beams (pre-tensioned and post-tensioned) for Viaduct, Bridge, Flyover construction etc., and
    - (ii) Must have experience in manufacture, and supply of other precast elements i.e., (a) Parapet Wall, (b) Pier Cross Head/Hammer Head (c) Precast Culvert/ Drain (d) Precast Pile (minimum any two items);
    - (iii) Must have own precast casting yard in the Sarawak state;
    - (iv) Must demonstrate that all pre-cast elements are to be manufactured in the Sarawak State using substantial local talents and resources. A support letter from the intended local partner(s) shall be included in the tender submission.
  - (f) The Tenderer or its shareholders, or any of their respective subsidiaries and/or affiliates, shall not participate in this tender process, or submit a Tender Submission, together with any other Tenderer.
  - (g) Any entity that has been declared successful in previous tenders, including but not limited to the company itself, its shareholders, or any of their respective subsidiaries and/or affiliates, is expressly prohibited from participating in the current tender process or submitting a Tender Submission jointly with any other Tenderer. Such entities are bound by this prohibition to maintain the integrity and competitiveness of the tendering process, and any breach of this prohibition may result in disqualification and other appropriate legal remedies.

**NOTE:**

In the event the Tenderer is a JV, then the above requirements may be fulfilled by the partners jointly and they shall be required to submit related supporting documents for each of the items above as evidence/proof.

5. Tender Document shall only be sold to "bona fide" representative of the Tenderers who attended the Tender Briefing session. Sarawak Metro **SHALL NOT** entertain any requisition for the purchase of Tender Document before and/or after the time stipulated.
6. Tenderers shall observe and comply with statutory requirements, rules and regulations, including and modifications to it or re-enactment that is enforced by the Government of Malaysia applicable in Sarawak.
