



REGISTRATION FOR SOCIO-ECONOMIC ENHANCEMENT DEVELOPMENT (SEED) PROGRAMME CONSULTANTS

Sarawak Metro Sdn Bhd (SMSB), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sarawak Economic Development Corporation (SEDC), has been entrusted by the Sarawak Government to develop the Kuching Urban Transportation System (KUTS) towards transforming the public transport system by minimising and alleviating the traffic congestions in the Greater Kuching area. At the heart of KUTS is the Automated Rapid Transit (ART) which will be the backbone of the public transport system transformation. With ART, SMSB aims to provide a safe, reliable, convenient, comfortable and environmentally-friendly public transport system for urban commuters. The development of KUTS also includes the Socio-Economic Enhancement Development (SEED) Programme which is similar to the Offset/ Industrial Collaboration Programme (ICP) implemented for Federal Government funded projects of more than RM50 million from foreign suppliers. The SEED Programme consists of activities that add value to the procurement made by the Government, to maximise the benefits from the procurement.

The intent of this registration for SEED Consultants is to identify potential vendors, who will subsequently be invited to submit competitive tenders for the SEED Programme as stated in the table below. SEED programme is initiated by SMSB to generate value-added deliverables from the procurement contract under the KUTS project. It acts as a means of acquiring new capacity and capabilities to generate additional industrial and economic activities.

SARAWAK METRO wishes to invite prospective vendors to register as SEED Programme Consultants with SMSB by submitting a duly completed Vendor Registration Form with supporting information and documents. All applications shall be made by the Company or Firm that possesses the following criteria and duly signed by an authorised officer.

- a) Preferably a Sarawakian owned or a partner company
- b) Fit and proper with relevant skillsets, at least one (1) key personnel with a minimum of five (5) years relevant experience in handling Offset /Industrial Collaboration Programme
- c) Possess experience related to managing offset/counter trade and Industrial Collaboration Programme.

Vendor Registration Forms can be downloaded from the SMSB website at www.mysarawakmetro.com and it is the Vendor's responsibility to ensure that all submissions are complete, with the necessary supporting documents duly attached. Incomplete submissions and inadequate informations will delay and inability to process the Vendors's registration.
